Dear EU/ITA Supplier

We are all still waiting for clarification from the EU Commission on the exact timing and details of the **implementation** of the new EU Regulation (EU) 1115/2023 EUDR, which is currently scheduled for 30.12.2025. For this reason, **unless otherwise instructed by the EU Commission**, we hereby inform you that, starting from that date, all goods destined to us will have to be accompanied by the following information for each product or part of it in the case of composite products:

• If the goods fall under the scope of the EUTR, as they were released for free circulation or placed on the market <u>before 30.12.2025</u>, it will be necessary to specify this and to state on the accompanying documentation the botanical name and country of origin/cutting of the individual products and a reference (also internal registration number) that can easily be traced back to the documents required for the supply in the event of a check by the Authorities to your company.

Example:

Product description: European oak boards

Botanical name: quercus robur (non-spp denomination)

Country of origin: Croatia

Reference standard: EUTR (internal reference n° xxxx dated dd.mm.yyyy and/or ref. DD

EUTR yyyy/xxx)

If, on the other hand, the goods fall within the scope of the EUDR, as they have been released for free circulation or placed on the market <u>starting from 30.12.2025</u>, then it will be necessary to state on the accompanying documentation the Reference Number for each product and its Verification Code, if applicable, of its own Declaration of Due Diligence, or the Reference Number and Verification Code, if applicable, of the Declaration of Due Diligence of the upstream party in the supply chain who first placed the product on the EU market.

Example:

Product description: European oak boards

Botanical name: quercus robur (non-spp denomination)

Country of origin: Croatia

Reference standard: EUDR Reference Number XXXXXXXXXXXXXX and Verification

Code xxxxxxxx if applicable

The EUTR/EUDR information must be disclosed and approved BEFORE the goods leave your company.

Additional documentation will be requested in the cases specified in Regulation (EU) 1115/2023.
